



- 7. Would you enjoy living somewhere like Solace? Why is somewhere like Solace a good or "not so good" place to live?
- 8. To what extent do you think Liam's adult personality fits with the childhood he experienced, assuming that we believe, to some extent at least, Elizabeth's and his own portrayal of what occurred?
- 9. What is the significance of the cat in the novel?
- 10. Which character in the story do you have the most empathy for and why?
