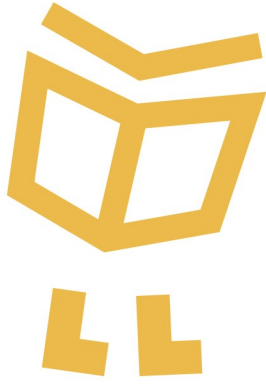

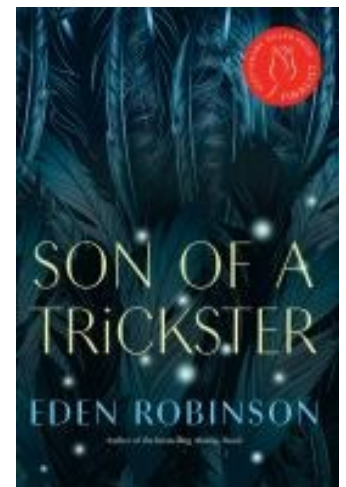


Son of a Trickster
